



# Two die as trailer crashes at Piri

TWO persons lost their lives while one other sustained injuries in the wee hours of Saturday, when a Daf truck crashed at Piri village, along Kwali- Lokoja road.

A witness said the accident happened when the truck with registration number XA 925 LSR that was loaded with cows lost

control while and crashed into a ditch, killing two persons on board.

The witness said the driver might have slept off due to fatigue.

Commenting on the incident, Yangoji FRSC unit Commander, Calistus Ndubisi Nwuka, attributed the accident cause to fatigue on the driver's part.

He said the corpses were deposited at

the University of Abuja Teaching Hospital's morgue at Gwagwalada, while the injured victim is at Kwali General Hospital.

The commander further stated that one person also died, while four others sustained injuries last Friday night in another accident that occurred at Sabon-Gari village, along the same road.

He said the accident happened at around

7 pm and involved a J5 Peugeot bus with registration number XA 280 KSD which rammed into a stationery truck with registration number XB 328 RRn, killing one person.

He said the victim's corpse is at the University of Abuja Teaching Hospital's morgue, while the injured victim is in Kwali General Hospital.
