

Kaduna Sunday explosion

Relation of VP's aide killed

IBRAHIM Musa, a relation of the media aide of Vice President Mohammed Namadi Sambo, Umar Sani, was among those killed in the Sunday explosion in Kaduna.

Musa Haruna, the father of the victim who is also the Ward Head of Ja'afaru Estate, Kabala Costain, Kaduna, lost his 18-year-old son, while his nephew survived with injuries.

Narrating his ordeal to *Daily Trust*, he said, "my son, Ibrahim Musa was 18 years old, and a staff of the National Board for Technical Education (NBTE) while my nephew, Aminu Muhammad Zakari 22 years old, a second year medical lab student of Bayero University Kano (BUK) left that fateful morning to Tudun Wada on a motorcycle to collect the rug of the mosque in the area that was taken for washing at a laundry service at Tudun Wada.

"They were both caught in the middle of the bomb blast immediately they negotiated the Sardauna Crescent, heading towards Stadium roundabout.

"My son, Ibrahim died on the spot, while Aminu was rushed with other victims to Saint Gerald Hospital, where he was later transferred to Ahmadu Bello University Teaching Hospital, Shika, Zaria because of the severity of the injury that affected his face.

KADUNA State Police Commissioner Muhammad Jinjiri Abubakar yesterday said no church was affected by the Sunday bomb blast in Kaduna that killed about 25 people. He made this known
