

# Pregnant Fulani woman killed in Plateau

UNIDENTIFIED persons have shot a pregnant Fulani woman at Ashanong village in Bachit District of Riyom Local Government of Plateau State.

The victim identified as Malama Adama Wada by the Miyetti Allah Cattle Breeders Association of Nigeria (MACBAN) was sitting outside her home when unidentified gunmen shot her.

The incident, our correspondent learnt happened on Sunday night.

State Secretary of the MACBAN, Malam Muhammad Nura said the deceased who was a mother of five was also six months pregnant.

"Information reaching us revealed that Malama Adama Wada was shot by gunmen while she was resting outside her house. You know people now come outside to get fresh air because of the heat being experienced, that was when some gunmen shot her."

He added, "we learnt that the deceased who has five children is also six months pregnant" and further called for investigation into the matter.

It would be recalled that, one Mrs. Ana Christopher a mother of seven was also killed on the same day by unknown persons at Lwa village in the same Bachit District of Riyom Local Government by unknown persons.

Police Public Relations Officer ASP, Samuel Dabai, confirmed the incident saying the matter is under investigation.
