3 feared killed in Lagos as rival cult groups clash

NO fewer than three persons were said to have died and scores injured when two rival cult groups clashed at Agric Bus Stop area of Ikorodu in Lagos on Tuesday evening.

Though normalcy returned to the place, Daily Trust reliably learnt that the fracas brought to halt commercial activities in the area for several hours before the arrival of the police.

But police authorities said only one

person was killed during the crisis.

Witnesses alleged that the cultists were allegedly contracted by some land speculators in the area to help them recover several hetares of land that had been seized by a notorious land grabber.

The Lagos State Police Public Relations Officer, Mr. Joseph Jaiyeoba, confirmed the incident.
