Gunmen kill director in Kano

UNKNOWN gunmen have killed an assistant director with the Board of Internal Revenue at his residence located around Kofar Gadon Kaya area of Kano metropolis after snatching his car.

A source told Weekly Trust that the gunmen visited the victim at his home and asked him to give them his Honda CRV vehicle to carry out "Allah's work" which he did without question.

"The gunmen came back shortly after they left and again demanded the victim to tell them how to unlock the vehicle's security system, threatening to shoot him if he refused. When the victim told them that he couldn't tell them anything more since he has given them the car, they shot and killed him instantly," the source narrated.

It was learnt that the assailants had already disappeared into the city before they could be captured by some volunteers who pursued them.

The deceased is believed to be a member of the Shia Islamic movement led by Sheik Ibrahim Elzakzaky.

The state Commissioner of Police, Ibrahim K. Idris who confirmed the incident, said the attack was carried out by two gunmen on a motorcycle who fled shortly after killing the victim.

He said that an investigation into the killing has been initiated by the police.
