

Gunmen kill FAAN staff in Kaduna

UNKNOWN gunmen have killed Aliyu Buba, 30, a staff of the Federal Airport Authority of Nigeria (FAAN) in Kano. He was shot dead and thrown out of his car along Rabah road in Kaduna,

his elder brother said. It was gathered that Aliyu, who was on a one week casual leave in Kaduna was killed on Wednesday by unknown gunmen.

Speaking with *Daily Trust*, the deceased's elder brother said the lifeless body of his younger

brother was found along the road. "Nobody knows the killer of my brother. We were only told that he was thrown out of his Honda Civic car by unknown gunmen after shooting him. His car was found around 1.am near Arewa House," he said.

The spokesperson of the Kaduna State Police Command, DSP Aminu Lawan, confirmed the incident.

"Yes, a man was killed and we have commenced investigation on it. We recovered his car two hours after he was killed," he said.
