## Five policemen arrested over murder in Lagos

FIVE policemen attached to Isashi police station in Lagos are presently being detained at the homicide section of State Criminal Investigations Department (SCID), Yaba for allegedly killing a commercial motorcyclist at Iba New Site area of Lagos metropolis.

The policemen were alleged to have pushed the motorbike rider, simply identified as Efong, out of a moving police patrol van after seizing the deceased motorbike.

An eyewitness alleged that the policemen allegedly impounded the motorbike belonging to Efiong along Iba area and insisted that the bike must be taken to their station.

It was also alleged that the policemen were angered at the insistence of the victim that he must know where

they were taking his bike to.
"Mid way into the journey, one of the policeman, identified as Killer pushed the victim out of the police patrol van. The deceased fell hitting his head on the road and died immediately" the

witness alleged.

The witness further said that motorbike riders in the area quickly mobilized themselves and gave the fleeing policemen a hot chase. Two of the policemen were arrested by the group while the other three took to their

heels.

The commercial motorbike operators numbering over 20 stormed Isashi police station demanding that the other fleeing policemen be

handed over to them.

The Lagos State Police
Public Relations Officer
(PPRO), DSP Ngozi Braide,
who confirmed the incident,
said all the five policemen
have since been arrested and

handed over to the homicide

section of SCID for investigations.
