

Man, 52, stabbed to death in Katsina

A 53-year-old Yusuf Ibrahim of Yar'adua quarters in Katsina metropolis has been stabbed to death by yet-to-be identified persons. "The late Ibrahim was stabbed in the stomach, neck and back," Police authorities confirmed.

The Deputy Police Public Relations Officer, Katsina State Command, ASP Shehu Koko

Muhammad, confirmed to Sunday Trust on phone yesterday that, the late Ibrahim was ambushed by his killers at Filin Samji area in the state metropolis on Thursday and stabbed in three different places.

"The late Ibrahim was riding his motorcycle when one of the killers stopped him and stabbed him with an object suspected to be knife, shortly after, two other hoodlums joined their colleague by stabbing

late Yusuf until he felt down unconscious," said Muhammad.

"We are suspecting that Yusuf was killed by the notorious Yandaba otherwise known as Kauraye," he alleged. Muhammad added that, Ibrahim was rushed to Hospital alive, but he later died at Federal Medical Centre where he was receiving treatment. He said late Ibrahim was able to give his statement to police in the hospital

before he died.

He pointed out that police has commenced investigation to unveil the killers of late Ibrahim, assuring that "no stone would be left unturned in the course of our investigation."

The deceased's junior brother, Sulaiman Ibrahim told *Sunday Trust* that, "my brother lost a lot of blood at Katsina General Hospital. We spent sometimes at the hospital but nobody attend to my brother due to lack of facilities as claimed by nursing officers on duty."
