An auto crash claimed 10 persons in Adigbe area of Abeokuta yesterday. It was gathered that a commercial bus marked LAGOS CZ 269 MUS, which was conveying passengers from Lagos had a head on collision with an articulated bus. The Itori Unit Commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) Fatai Bakare, said 11 people were involved in the accident.

Bakare said the articulate vehicle marked LAGOS 208 XB, was on its way to Lagos when it collided with the bus which was on its way to Abeokuta at the Obada-Oko Adigbe junction.

"All the deceased have been deposited at Federal Medical Centre and Ifo General Hospital, Abeokuta. The only survivor is critically injured and receiving treatment at FMC.
