The Rivers Police Command yesterday confirmed the killing of two persons and injuring of a policeman in Port Harcourt in Rivers State by armed robbers.

Ben Ugwuegbulam, spokesman of the command, said in Port Harcourt that the robbery took place between 8am and 9am along the Isaac Boro Park fly-over in the city, saying no arrest had been made but that the police were investigating the matter. The policeman, according to him, was injured while responding to a distress call and tried to foil the operation together with some other policemen. Ugwuegbulam however said the robbers got away with their loot but promised that the police would track them down.

The police spokesman said the victims of the robbery were conveying an undisclosed sum of money in a commercial vehicle when they were attacked. (NAN)
