Two persons lost their lives on Tuesday evening when two vehicles collided near Piri village, along Kwali- Lokoja road.

Our reporter gathered from onlookers that three others, who sustained serious injuries, were rushed to Kwali General Hospital by Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC) officials.

A witness said the accident happened when a bus with registration number LG 18 KAB overtook another vehicle while on speed and collided with a Toyota Carina car with registration number LR 762 AB, causing the death of two persons.

He said the dead were male and female passengers inside the Toyota car, while three others, including a child sustained injuries.

When contacted, Yangoji FRSC unit Commander, Austine Chukwudi Okeke, confirmed the death and said the corpses are at Kwali General Hospital's morgue.

He said the injured victims are also in the same hospital, while the command is investigating the accident cause.

In another accident, seven persons including an under- aged child were injured on Tuesday night at Yangoji village, along Kwali- Lokoja road.

A witness said the accident happened at 9:15 pm, when a Nissan Sunny car with registration number ET 87 AAA collided with a Toyota Camry car.

"The injured were rushed to the hospital by FRSC officials who came to the accident scene on time," he said.

FRSC unit Commander, Austine Chukwudi Okeke, said the injured are at the Kwali General Hospital.
