Eight killed in Katsina road accident

No fewer than eight persons, including four children, have lost their lives in a road accident at Kamfanin-Mai Lafiya in Yankara village in Faskari local

government of Katsina State yesterday.

Seven survivors of the accident sustained various degrees of injuries and are currently receiving treatment at the Accident and Emergency Department of Funtua General hospital.

Corpses of the dead victims were deposited at the hospital's morgue.
