Gunmen kill woman in Benue

A 26-year- old nursing mother was yesterday reportedly found dead in her home at Taraku in Gwer Local Government Area of Benue state.

Sewuse Tyoor was believed to have been murdered by unknown gunmen who had stormed her home at night and also brutally injuring her 18-months old baby, Goodluck Tyoor.

Witnesses said the killing might not be unconnected with the on-going trial of some persons suspected to have killed the deceased's husband in a similar circumstance early last year.

The woman before her gruesome murder was said to have identified four staffs of the National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (NDLEA) currently standing trial as suspected

killers of her late husband, Chia Tyoor.

Although, the case is due for hearing on January 15, 2013, neighbours continue to wonder why the evil men decided to take the deceased's life and manhandled the innocent child.

"We woke up to discover Madam Sewuse in her own pool of blood. Even the baby Goodluck was thought initially to have died following the severe injury done to him but the local government chairman who came with police and took away the mother's corpse later

informed us that the child is still alive.

"We have never seen such wickedness in this town, the husband was killed last year and today is his wife, what on earth has he done that cannot be forgiven?" a neighbour remarked tearfully.

Meanwhile, the local council chairman, Daivd Maor has confirmed that the infant is receiving treatment at a missionary hospital while the mother's corpse had been deposited at the local government General Hospital for

further investigation.

At the time of filing this report, the police could not confirm the incident as several calls were not answered.
