One dies in New Nyanya auto crash

A motorcyclist was at the weekend crushed to death by a grey Toyota Carina car at New Nyanya junction, along the New Nyanya and Keffi road in Nasarawa State.

The cyclist's passenger, an elderly woman however survived but sustained serious injuries.

A witness said the cyclist attempted to cross the highway and crashed into a fast moving car.

"Both rider and passenger were flung into the air and landed heavily on the ground. The cyclist died instantly, while his passenger sustained life threatening injuries," he said.

Our reporter witnessed when the passenger who had massive

fractures on several parts of her body was carried into a police van and the driver of the Toyota car told to drive the car to a police station.

A traffic warden said the accident could have been avoided if commercial cyclists
