One killed, 5 injured in Kogi auto crash

ONE person yesterday died while five others sustained serious injuries in an accident that occurred at Ohono village along the Lokoja-Abuja road.

Witnesses said the inccident happened around 2 pm when a Toyota vehicle overtook another vehicle and in the process collided with an oncoming vehicle, killing one person on the spot.

They said three other vehicles rammed into the vehicle from behind, leaving five persons injured.

The Sector Commander of the Federal Road Safety Commission, Muhammed Garba, who confirmed the accident also blamed it on dangerous overtaking.

He said the accident involved a Toyota Avalon car with registration number KWL F876 AC, Honda Accord with registration NF 743 ABC, KIA Jeep KW 751 AK and Shova with registration number RSH 743 AC.

Muhammed said 12 people were involved in the multiple accident, adding that the corpses had been deposited at the Federal Medical Centre where the injured were also being treated.
