Weekly Trust gathered that the gunmen surrounded the house of the victims around 1am and set it High Court jail kidnappers for 10 yrs ablaze. They also opened fire on those who tried to escape. The attack came barely a week after a Chinese railway worker and a Nigerian were killed in the Share FG to spend N14b on dry season rice farming nearby Kirim village on the border of Kaduna and Plateau states. Kaura local government area has experienced series of attacks since April 2013, which had claimed Roadside explosive kills 7, injures 3 others in Borno hundreds of lives and destroyed property worth millions of naira.
