Man stabs friend to death at Mabushi

A 20-year old man, Sani Musa, has been stabbed to death at Mabushi village by his friend.

The deceased of Dumping Area, off Banex-Gwarinpa Expressway, was allegedly stabbed by one Umar from Kaduna State.

The Mabushi divisional police officer, Superintendent Stanley Imo, who confirmed the incident, also disclosed that one Agnes Uchedi was nearly killed in the same area on Saturday.

He said the deceased was killed over a little disagreement with his assailant, who was his friend.

The police officer said the case is a capital offence and has

been transferred to the FCT criminal investigation department for further investigation.

"Those boys are dangerous and can do anything to sustain themselves. Residents should be careful and must report to police as soon as they see anybody following them behind. We are not spirits, we need information from the residents," he said.

Narrating her ordeal, the woman, who narrowly escaped death in the area on Saturday, Agnes Uchedi, said the incident took place when she was returning home from work.

"I finished from work late on Saturday and I was heading home; I couldn't see any taxi, so I decided to walk down but was stopped by some group of men, who harassed, beat me up and

stole all the money I made that day. I shouted and nobody, not even the police, came to my rescue. I was later told at the police station that the place is a very dangerous zone," she said.

A mechanic, who gave his name as Mohammed, told our reporter that he bought a car engine to fix on a customer's car recently, but it was stolen, adding that after reporting the matter to the police, it was found at the same area where the boys operate.

Other residents, who spoke to our reporter, described the situation as very pathetic and unfortunate.

They called on the police and other stakeholders to come to their aid in order to address the situation.
