



## Nigeria: Police Arrest Two Over Murder in Kogi

Lokoja — The Kogi State Police Command has arrested two suspects, Farouk Muhammed and Sadiq Ibrahim, over the killing of one Grace Abata in Okene.

Grace Abata was murdered in Agassa area of Okene in Okene Local Government Area in January, 2013, by suspected hoodlums allegedly dressed in army uniform.

Daily Trust gathered that the duo were arrested by the Criminal Investigation Department of the command.

Police Public Relations Officer in the state, Mr. Romanus Nwaneri, who confirmed the arrest in Lokoja, said the suspects are giving useful information to the police, adding that the information would enable them track down the remaining suspects who are at large.

He said the case was not bailable, and that the suspects would remain in police custody until investigation is completed.

Nwaneri said the police are ready to ensure a peaceful environment for law abiding citizens to go about their legitimate businesses.
