Nigeria: Gunmen Kill Lady, Man in Kano

Unknown gunmen yesterday evening launched an attack at Badawa Bus Stop area in Kano metropolis, killing a female phone recharge card vendor and a man.

The attackers also injured another man.

Eyewitnesses told Daily Trust that the assailants had arrived the area before 6pm in auto-rickshaw which they parked at a distance before proceeding to rain bullets on their victims.

A trader at the area said the female victim was sitting outside her shop when the gunmen shot her at close range.

The man, who said the shooting had forced people to take to their heels, said the gunmen also opened fire on two other victims

Daily Trust learnt that the busy bus station area was deserted immediately after killing.

On Tuesday, unknown gunmen shot dead a auto-rickshaw operator in the morning and took away his vehicle.

Confirming yesterday's killings, a police officer who does not want to be named, said the gunmen had escaped the scene before the arrival of their men.
