Police, 3 others killed in Kumo

Gunmen stormed Kumo the headquarters of Akko local government area of Gombe State in a midnight attack which led to the killing of a policeman and a civilian, said police sources.


According to a witness who wanted to remain anonymous, the gunmen went to the area at about 11:00 pm and started shooting sporadically, and in the process, killed three people and one policeman and shot one civilian in the leg.

The witness, who said the incident lasted for about four hours, noted that the attackers targeted the Kumo Divisional Police Headquarters but they were unable to reach the police building.

Speaking to Sunday Trust correspondent on telephone, the Police Public Relations Officer, DSP Fwaje Attajire, said, "The attackers targeted the Police Divisional Headquarters building but were repelled." When asked of the casualties and the extent of damage, the PPRO said, "We cannot ascertain the extent of damage and casualties now but will get back to the press later."

But up to the time of filing this report, the police had not talked to the press.
