Four killed in Bauchi auto crash

Four persons, among them a baby boy, died and two others sustained injuries yesterday in a fatal road accident that occurred in Funji village in Giade local government area of Bauchi State.

Sector Commandant of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) for the state Henry Sunday Olatunji said the accident which occurred early in the morning yesterday involved a trailer and a Toyota car. He also said it involved six persons, out of which four died and two other sustained injuries.

Olatunji said FRSC men came to the scene and evacuated all the dead bodies and those injured to the Federal Medical Centre in Azare.

The commandant also said accident was caused by reckless driving on the part of the trailer driver who left his lane and collided with car and appealed to the owners of heavy duty vehicles to caution their drivers to obey traffic rules and regulations.
