# MAN, 51, ARRAIGNED OVER MANSLAUGHTER

The police in Abuja on Thursday arraigned one Peter Waide before an Abuja Senior Magistrates' Court over alleged manslaughter.

Waide resides at Prince and Princess Estate in Gudu district area of Abuja, FCT.

The police prosecutor, Cpl. Francis Tanko, told the court that the accused reported himself at the Wuse Police Station on May 20.

He said the accused drove his Mercedes car with registration number BU 986 ABC dangerously and hit one Samuel Edeh of Galadimawa village Abuja, leading to his death.

Tanko said the offence runs contrary to Section 27 CAP 548 of the Road Traffic Act (RTA).

Section 27 CAP 548 of the RTA says, “A person who causes the death of another person by the driving of a motor vehicle on a highway recklessly is guilty of an offence liable on conviction to imprisonment for a term of seven years.”

The accused pleaded not guilty to the charge.

Senior Magistrate Usman Shuiabu granted the accused bail in the sum of N500,000 with one surety in like sum.

He said the surety must be a civil servant from Grade Level 10 above and should swear an affidavit that he knows the accused.

The case was adjourned to June 19 for hearing. (NAN)


