



ACCIDENT VICTIM RESCUERS ATTACK KUBWA HOSPITAL ATTENDANT

There was a mild drama **Friday night** at the Kubwa General Hospital when two young men, who brought the corpse of a man involved in a ghastly **auto crash** at **Dutse**, attacked one of the hospital's attendants.

A witness at the hospital said the attendant had told the men, who came with a police officer to hold on outside the Accident and Emergency unit of the hospital for the doctor to come.

He said the response of the attendant did not go down well with the angry men and they pounced on him and injured him on the hand.

The deceased was said to have rammed into a trailer along the ever busy Dutse-Bwari road.

A witness, who put the **accident time at 10.15pm**, said the deceased sustained serious injuries and his car was badly damaged, adding that he was later rushed to the Kubwa General Hospital.

At the hospital, the head of the Accident and Emergency unit, Paul Olise, said the deceased sustained laceration of the forehead and had been deposited at the hospital mortuary.
