



DRIVER KILLS 5 IN OSOGBO

The Federal Road Safety Commission, Osun State Sector has identified recklessness as the cause of an incident which occurred at Ogo-Oluwa area in Osogbo, the state capital.

The FRSC sector commander in the state, Mr. Imoh Etuk, yesterday confirmed that least five persons died in the accident while several other people sustained

Etuk told Daily Trust that the accident which involved a private car, a mini bus and two motorcycles was caused by impatience on the part of the driver of the private car, who, according to him was driving recklessly.

He said the recklessness on the part of the driver of the private car led to a headon collision and his car skidded and somersaulted over the median and landed on the opposite side of the road.

Daily Trust gathered that one of those that died in the incident was a young man who was preparing for his wedding.

Etuk said other victims of the accident who sustained injuries are currently receiving treatment at the Ladoke Akintola University of Technology (LAUTECH) Teaching Hospital, Osogbo.
