POLICE NAB SUSPECTED KILLERS OF COY MANAGER

Police in Benue State have paraded four suspected killers of a regional manager with West African Milk Company (WAMCO) alongside 26 others arrested for various criminal offences.

On June 3, Rasaki Lukman, a management staff of WAMCO, was found dead in his two-bedroom flat located near Modern Market in Makurdi.

The state police commissioner, Adams Audu, who paraded the suspects before news-men at the command's headquarters, said his reign would not tolerate any act of criminality in the state.


He said the late Lukman's killers were apprehended by detectives, who in the course of investigation tracked down the deceased's car at a hotel in Abuja, where negotiation for its sale was going on.

Audu identified the suspects as; Philip David, Owoicho Egwu, Ochai Obeh and Osuga Eziekiel, saying they have confessed to the crime.

"The men confessed to the dastardly killing of the man by inflicting severe injuries on him, tying his hands and legs and locking him in a room," he said.

The commissioner displayed items reco-vered from the suspects to include; the deceased's 2010 model Toyota Corolla car, one GSM handset with two SIM cards, clipper, printer, one vehicle number plate and two black belts among others.

Fielding questions from journalists, one of the suspects, Obeh admitted that they robbed the late manager of his vehicle and tied him up in his apartment, buy denied killing him.
