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MAN CRUSHED TO DEATH WHILE CROSSING ROAD AT MABUSHI

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An unidentified man was yesterday afternoon crushed to death by a hit and run driver while trying to cross the ever busy Mabushi express way.

A witness, Nasir Ibrahim, an orange seller, told City News that the deceased was a scavenger.

"He alighted from a bus and tried to cross the road when a moving jeep crushed him and his brain was scattered on the road. I know him because he used to pack things from the trash bin but I don't know his name. The driver did not stop and we reported the matter to the police. Police immediately came and removed his body," the witness said.

A police officer at the scene of the incident, said his body will be deposited at Maitama General hospital morgue.

When contacted, Mabushi Divisional Police Officer, Deputy Superintendent Stanley Imo, confirmed the incident and advised that people should make use of the pedestrian bridge while crossing the express way.

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
