Two monarchs, seven others remanded over clash in Kwara

A MAGISTRATE Court in Ilorin, Kwara State, has ordered that two rival traditional rulers in Ganmo community in the state be remanded in prison.

The traditional rulers who are the Oniganmo of Ganmo, Anafi Zubairu and Oluganna of Ganmo, Abdullahi Atanda Kolawole, both of whom backed by their respective people in the crisis, are feuding over the rightful paramount ruler of the town.

One of the rulers comes from Ilorin tribal group while the other is from the Igbomina group, as the two groups form the indigenes of the community.

The traditional rulers were arraigned alongside seven others before the Magistrate Court over the clash between their supporters last week where three people lost their lives and property worth millions of naira destroyed.

Two people each reportedly lost their lives from both the Oniganmo and Oniganna's sides during the clash.
