Nigeria: Driver Dies in Apo Auto Crash

A driver, One Tobias of New Nyanya in Nassarawa state was Wednesday afternoon killed in a fatai accident that occurred at Apo in Abuja.

A witness, Musa Adamu, an auto parts dealer said the incident happened at Kabusa junction and it involves a Golf car with registration number DK 769 ABC and a Peugeot car with registration number BE 97 BEN.

The witness said "It was an head on collision and in the process, the driver of the golf car, who was coming out of Apo to the city centre, identified as Tobias of New Nyanya died on the spot while seven other occupants were seriously injured and receiving treatment at Asokoro General Hospital,".

A police traffic warden at the scene told our reporter that the two drivers were impatience. "What happened today caused terrible traffic congestion on the Apo road but we managed to control the traffic even with the rain," he said.

When contacted, FCT police spokesperson, Deputy Superintendent Hyelhira Altine Daniel, confirmed the incident and said investigation on the matter is still ongoing.

"Road users should be patient with one another, now a life is lost out of one person's carelessness. We are glad that those injured are recuperating," she said.
