

# 6 perish in auto crash at Yangoji village

Six passengers lost their lives while three others sustained various degrees of injuries on Sunday evening as two vehicles collided at Yangoji village, along Kwali-Lokoja road.

A witness said the accident happened around 6:12 pm when the driver of an Opel Vectra car with registration number BVG 193 AA, lost control while on top speed and collided with an

oncoming Toyota Camry car with registration number BR 611 KUJ, killing the six persons on the spot.

He said the Opel driver and five other passengers from the two vehicles died instantly, adding that officials of the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC) immediately rushed to the scene and removed the corpses of the dead passengers to the hospital.

When contacted, Yangoji

FRSC unit commander, Austine Chukwudi Okeke, confirmed the accident, saying six persons comprising four male and two female died in the accident and that their corpses have been deposited at Kwali General Hospital morgue.

He said the three injured victims are at the same hospital receiving treatments.

The unit commander attributed the accident to loss of control by one of the drivers.

He further disclosed that two persons were injured in another accident which occurred on Saturday night at Gada-Biyu village, along Kwali-Abuja-Lokoja road.

Okeke said the lone accident happened around 9pm and it involved a Mitsubishi truck with registration number XT 746 JJJ.

He informed that the two injured victims were taken to Kwali General Hospital for attention.
