GIRL CRUSHED TO DEATH AT DUTSE

A 15-year-old girl was crushed to death yesterday morning by a speeding vehicle at Sokale area of Dutse, along Dutse-Bwari road.

A witness said the deceased was crossing the ever-busy road with her mother when the driver of a Honda car coming from Bwari axis knocked her down and killed her on the

He said the car swerved off the road and plunged into the gutter, while the driver managed to come out of the car unhurt.

The witness, who put the accident time at around 8am, said the deceased, who sustained serious injury on the head, was taken to the Kubwa General hospital.

The head, Accident and Emergency Unit of the hospital, Paul Olise, confirmed that the girl died, adding that her body had already been deposited at the hospital morgue.

When contacted, Dutse unit commander of the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC), Igwe Henry, an Assistant Corps Commander, confirmed the incident, saying her corpse has been deposited at Kubwa General Hospital.

He said investigation into the cause of the accident was ongoing.
