

MAN STABS GIRLFRIEND TO DEATH IN DELTA

A man in his late 20s, Lucky Ndakwe has reportedly stabbed his girlfriend to death at a riverside in Bomadi, headquarters of Bomadi Local Government Area of Delta State.

Weekly Trust learnt that the boy hits the girl with a bottle of beer on Thursday night over the allegation that she was going out with his friend.

However, when the man confronted his girlfriend at about 7.30 p.m. at the town's waterside over suspicion of cheating on him, it degenerated into a heated argument, sources disclosed, adding that when the deceased could not swallow the unruly behaviour of her boyfriend, she decided to walk away, but this infuriated the boyfriend who dragged her on the ground and slapped her continuously. Weekly Trust further learnt that when the girl was trying to fight back, the suspect rushed for a bottle of beer, hit it on her head before stabbing her. When he saw that the girl was bleeding profusely, he attempted to run but was apprehended by onlookers.

Every attempt to save the girl's life was unsuccessful, as she died on her way to the hospital. This sparked some protests but security agents did not allow aggrieved people to lynch the man, sources said.

It was gathered that the corpse of the girl had been deposited at Bomadi General Hospital while police had commenced investigations into the matter.

Delta State Police Public Relations Officer, Mr. Lucky Uyabeme said he has not been fully briefed as at the time he was contacted over the incident.
