4 KEBBI LG WORKERS KILLED IN **AUTO CRASH**

Four finance clerks of Danko Wasagu Local Government Area of Kebbi State were killed in an auto crash while returning to Zuru from Ribah(Headquarters of the council) at the weekend.

A witness, Alhaji Usman Muhammad, told Daily Trust that the incident occurred around 7:30pm when the vehicle in which the council staff were travelling ran into a


"They were returning from Ribah during a heavy rainfall when they ran into a truck that was abandoned in the middle of the road. Three of the victims died on the spot while the fourth victim who sustained injuries was rushed to the hospital," he said.

A senior official with the Zuru Unit command of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) confirmed the incident.

It was gathered that corpses of the victims were taken to the mortuary at the General Hospital, Zuru, from where they were recovered by families for burial.

Counsellor of Danko Wasagu Babangida Dunga gave the names of the three that died at the scene of the incident as; Abbubakar Sahabi Shindi, Garba Kanya and Ibrahim Dantani.

Efforts to contact either the FRSC Unit Commander Zuru Mohammed Bature or the chairman of Danko Wasagu Local Government Area Rabi'u Muhammad Ribah was not successful. The Unit Commander was said to be on leave while the local government chairman was said to have travelled to Saudi Arabia for pilgrimage.
