A mobile police officer attached to the Special Task Force (STF) in Plateau State yesterday shot dead his colleague and injured two children at Tanjol village in Riyom local government area.

Our correspondent could not ascertain the circumstance that led to the shooting. But a member of the village described it as an accidental discharge.

The source gave the names and ages of the two injured children as Paul Pam, seven and eight years' old Florence Yohanna who are now receiving treatment at the Vom Christian hospital.

According to him, "the incident happened at about 8:30a.m. It was an accidental discharge. But the other MOPOL is dead and the two kids injured have been taken to the Vom Christian hospital."

The STF Media and Information Officer Captain Salisu Mustapha when contacted confirmed the incident and described it as sad and unfortunate. Mustapha said "Investigation and administrative procedures have commenced".
