TRUCK CRUSHES 5-YR-OLD BOY AT DUTSE

A 5-year-old boy was nearly killed by a heavy truck last Friday along Dutse road, in Bwari Area Council.

A witness said the boy, who was returning from school, was trying to cross the expressway when the incident happened.

He said the little boy was ran over by the driver of the truck, damaging his legs.

According to the witness, the boy was immediately taken to the Kubwa General hospital for treatment.

Similarly, a middle-aged motorcyclist was injured same day after colliding with a vehicle at Dei-Dei, along Abuja-Zuba expressway.

A witness said the victim was on the right lane of the road when a vehicle that drove against traffic hit him. He sustained injuries on parts of his head and body, and was taken to Kubwa General hospital for medical attention.

At the hospital, the head of accident and emergency unit, Paul Olise, said the little boy is responding to treatment while the cyclist has been discharged after being treated.
