









2 TRAPPED TO DEATH IN SABON-GARI CAR CRASH

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Two persons were trapped to death while four others sustained serious injuries in a fatal motor accident which occurred at Sabon-Gari village, along the Abuja-Lokoja highway.

An eyewitness said the accident involved a Volkswagen Golf car with registration number ANC 23 XA.

He said the driver of the car lost control of his vehicle and rammed into a moving truck from behind, killing the two persons on the spot.

The witness said the driver of the Volkswagen car and a passenger sitting beside him were trapped to death in the car, adding that men of the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC) visited the scene and took the corpses to the hospital.

Reacting, Yangoji unit commander of the FRSC, Austine Chukwudi Okeke, confirmed the accident, saying two persons, including the driver, have lost their lives and their corpses deposited at Kwali General Hospital.

The unit commander said four injured victims of the accident were taken to the same hospital. He disclosed that four persons were also injured in another accident which occurred on Sunday evening near Yangoji village, when a vehicle had its tyre burst and crashed into a ditch along the Abuja-Lokoja highway.

He said the accident happened at about 6:17 pm as the vehicle, a Volkswagen Golf, with registration number BE 615 YAB, had a tyre burst, adding that the injured victims were taken to Kwali General Hospital for medical attention.

"Also, this morning (yesterday), another accident occurred near RCC junction along the Kwali-Lokoja road, involving a Peugeot J5 bus with registration number XA 347 BMG.

He said the driver of the bus was seriously injured and was taken to Kwali General Hospital.

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
