

ONE KILLED IN RIVERS CULT WAR

One person was reportedly killed yesterday in a rival cult war in Okwali community of Khana Local Government Area of Rivers State. He died when rival cult groups engaged themselves in war supremacy.

Deputy speaker of the Rivers State House of Assembly, Leyii Kwanee, who spoke to journalists in Khana about the incident condemned in strong terms, the spate of cultism and violent gang war in some parts of Khana communities.

He said it was incredible that cultism was creeping back to the state after Governor Amaechi had dealt with form of such insecurity.

Kwanee, who is the member representing Khana Constituency 2 in the Assembly, urged those involved in such activities to desist from them and be law-abiding, and warned that should they continue with their nefarious activities, they stand the risk of being arraigned in court on charges of Secret Cult and Similar Activities (prohibition) law No 6 of 2004.

He further warned those with the habit of sponsoring such activities, saying that the law has a provision to take care of them.

He implored law enforcement agents to investigate the matter and ensure that the offenders are brought to book.

Kwanee said that Ogoni needed peace, particularly now that the 2015 general elections are around the corner.
