## APPREHENSION IN KOGI VARSITY AS SUSPECTED CULTISTS KILL 2 STUDENTS

Students of the Kogi State University Anyigba are now living in fear after suspected cultists allegedly killed two students last week Sunday.


A source within the campus said the students who are writing their first semester examination now live under fear, as they believe that a rival cult group may attempt to avenge the killings if the victims were its members.

According to him, the victims, Ernest Aruwa and his friend, whose name was yet to be ascertained, were 300 level students of Economics, adding that they were killed at night at their off campus residence located behind the university.

He said the assailants traced the victims to their home in the middle of the night and murdered them in cold-blood, adding that Aruwa was burnt beyond recognition after several machete injuries were inflicted on his body, while his friend died of machete wounds in the hospital.

Confirming the incident, the Kogi State Police Command Public Relations Officer, Nsikak Ekong, said only one of the students was killed, while the other was receiving treatment at an undisclosed hospital.

The police spokesperson said security had been beefed up in the area, assuring that the command was working round the clock to ensure that the perpetrators were apprehended.
