

ACCIDENT CLAIMS FAMILY OF 6 IN KADUNA

A family of six including father, mother and four of their children one of which is a two month old baby yesterday perished in a road accident along Kaduna-Kano expressway.

The accident happened when the 2004 model Honda Accord vehicle the family is travelling in skidded off the road hitting some trees by the side of the road.

An eyewitness said the accident occurred around 5.30pm just after a village called Daka Tsale.

An eyewitness, who gave his name as Muhammad said "I was just walking along the road when I noticed a car going off the road after a sharp bend on the express way.

There were six occupants in the vehicle, the man, his wife and their four children, including a two month old baby, all of whom died on the spot and we evacuated their bodies from the vehicle" he said.

The Information Officer of the Kaduna Command of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Japhet Dajangla could not be reached as at the time of filing in this report as his number was switched off.
