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2 KILLED AS BUSES COLLIDE AT GWAGWALADA

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Two persons were trapped to death when two buses had a head-on collision on Tuesday night at Gwako village, along the Abuja-Lokoja highway.

A witness said another person sustained serious injuries in the accident which happened around 8:43pm when the driver of a Peugeot J5 bus with registration number XA 507 DKA, overtook dangerously at a sharp bend and collided with an oncoming Fiat Ford bus with registration number EKJ 977 XB.

He said the drivers of the two buses were trapped after the buses collided, adding that men of the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC) Gwagwalada, came and removed their corpses to the hospital.

When contacted, the Gwagwalada unit commander of the FRSC, Alhaji Ahmed Abubakar, confirmed the accident and attributed it to over speeding and route violation. He said the corpses of the two bus drivers were taken to the University of Abuja Teaching Hospital's morgue at Gwagwalada, while the injured victim was taken to the accident and emergency unit of the hospital.

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
