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WANTED MURDER SUSPECT ARRESTED AT MARARABA

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An alleged notorious criminal, suspected to have murdered a middle-aged man at Mararaba, a neighbouring town to the Federal Capital Territory (FCT), Abuja, was recently arrested after almost one year of manhunt by the police.

Investigation revealed that the suspect was declared wanted by the 'A' Division Police Mararaba sometime in July last year when he allegedly stabbed one Mr. Shobin Adamu, a mason from Plateau State, to death at Kabayi area of the town and escaped.

Findings showed that the victim was murdered over what was described as a minor misunderstanding.

The police then vowed to bring the fleeing suspect to face the law and have been on his trail and finally tracked him down following a tip off.

Further investigation indicated that the murder suspect who is said to possess some 'magical powers' was overpowered by police detectives who caught him unawares at one of his hideouts at Kabayi in Mararaba, in what was said to be a very tough operation.

Our reporter gathered that the suspect, after committing the crime last year, fled to Benue State where he hails from, and has since then been moving from one location to another and later returned to Mararaba when he thought the storm was over.

City News stumbled on the arrested suspect being taken to the police station and learnt that he has been severally charged to court for causing grievous hurt and extortion.

When City News visited the police station, a senior police officer who craved anonymity, told our reporter that the suspect had confessed to the crime and will be moved to appropriate quarters for further action.

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
