MOTORIST CRUSHES 13-YR-OLD WATER VENDOR IN ABAJI

An unidentified 13-year-old girl, hawking sachet water was recently crushed to death by a speeding vehicle at Abaji roundabout, on the Abuja-Lokoja Highway.

A witness said the incident happened when the driver of a Toyota Jeep, coming from Gwagwalada axis was trying to avoid hitting another car that was driving out from a filling station.

He said the Jeep's driver, in the process, veered off and knocked down the girl, adding that officials of the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC) immediately arrived at the scene to convey her to hospital, where she was confirmed dead.

When contacted, Abaji unit commander of the FRSC, Moses Audu, confirmed the incident, saying the Jeep driver has been handed over to the police, while the vehicle was also at the police station. He said the remains of the girl were later handed over to her relatives for burial.

In a related incident, four persons were seriously injured in a motor accident which occurred on Tuesday afternoon at Awawa village, on the Abuja-Lokoja road.

A witness said the accident happened around 1:33 p.m. when a Honda car with registration number AG 274 WRR, had a tyre burst on top speed and the driver lost control and crashed into a barricade by the road side. He said the four injured victims were evacuated by the officials of the FRSC to a hospital at Abaji.

The FRSC unit commander in the area, Moses Audu, confirmed the accident, which he attributed to over speeding and tyre burst, saying the injured victims were taken to Abaji General Hospital.
