Gunmen attacked Sanga, four killed

FOUR people are killed as gunmen attacked a community in Sanga local government area of Kaduna State, the police and locals said yesterday.

The attack on Gimi community in the early hours of Friday followed several attacks on Sanga which have led to the killing of over 200, displacing about 14,000 people.

A resident told Weekly Trust that a woman and three men were killed while a girl of about two years, who sustained injuries during the attack, is receiving treatment at the Gwantu General Hospital, along with several others.

"We don't know what marauders are turning our land into. A lot of people are currently displaced in this particular attack on Gimi," a resident, Mike Sanga said.

"Four people were butchered to death in Gimi, another Sanga community in the early hours of today (yesterday)," Mike added.

Sanga local government chairman, Mr. Emmanuel Dan-Zaria, could not immediately be reached for comment.

Kaduna State police spokesman, Aminu Lawan, confirmed that four people were killed in the attack

"We are investigating the killing," Aminu said, adding that "our men are combing the bush."
