

UNIDENTIFIED MAN CRUSHED AT MABUSHI **FLYOVER**

An unknown hit-and-run motorist by Mabushi flyover, Abuja, has crushed an unidentified middle-aged man.

A witness said the man came from the opposite side of the road when they suddenly saw his head and blood splashed all over the expressway.

The witness identified the vehicle as a black Land Cruiser jeep, on high speed and that it was difficult to get the registration number as at the time the accident occurred.

When contacted, the Mabushi Divisional Police Officer, Superintendent Saheed Kazim, confirmed the accident and said the level of fatal accident at the VIO Junction, Mabushi flyover and Setraco is overwhelming.

Superintendent Kazim said accidents happen daily on that road, and people are killed because of their carelessness.

He said the major problem with the road is that residents prefer crossing the expressway to using pedestrian bridges.

The Mabushi police boss said the corpse of the deceased was taken to the mortuary while he advised pedestrians to always use the foot bridges and that any pedestrian caught crossing the highway would be charged to court.
