Boko Haram fighters have shot dead two people and burnt a police station in Gombi town in Adamawa State, witnesses said yesterday. Residents confirmed the incident to Weekly Trust in Yola, saying the insurgents were later repelled by security forces.

A security source revealed that a mobile policeman died while another was wounded during the encounter Governor Bala Ngilari said through his spokesman, Phineas Elisha that the militants carried out the attack in desperation after they were trapped by vigilantes and security forces who pursued them from Mubi.

Adamawa State police spokesman, DSP Othman Abubakar could not be reached for comment.
