

# Truck crashes into 14 vehicles

One person was killed on Saturday, when a delivery truck crashed into 14 other vehicles along the Nasarawa/Abuja border.

Daily Trust gathered that the accident which occurred at about noon, caused a gridlock in the area.

The police said the truck lost control and crashed into 14 other vehicles.

"We received a signal that a truck loaded with soft drinks lost control at Ado in Karu Local Government Area of Nasarawa State, and crashed into 14 other vehicles. One person was feared dead, and several others left with varying degrees of injuries. They were rushed to nearby hospitals for treatment," DSP Ugochukwu Theodore told Daily Trust.

He said policemen and operatives of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) responded promptly to evacuate the victims and clear the road.

Angry residents of Ado, who rushed to the scene of the accident, took on the bottling company, screaming abusive words at the truck owners for reckless driving.
