Nine travellers feared dead in Plateau

Nine passengers feared dead after an attack around Bisichi in Jos South LGA of Plateau State while on their way to Mangu and Barkin Ladi.

Mallam Sa'adu, a passenger who escaped the attack told journalists that that nine of his travelling companions were presumed dead.

He said: "We were on our way to Mangu when suddenly a group of people stopped our car. They attacked us with machetes but I pushed one of them and ran. They followed me but could not catch me. I stopped at a security checkpoint where I reported the incident."

"We were 10 in the car, some of us were to alight in Barikin Ladi while some in Mangu town. But after the attack, I later got a report that my other companions had been burnt in Bisichi."

Police spokesman, DSP Emmanuel Abu, said the command had a report that three persons were burnt beyond recognition after unknown gunmen opened fire at a car near Bisichi
