37 died in Kano suicide blast — NURTW

The National Union of Road Transport Workers (NURTW) in Kano said yesterday that 37 persons were killed in Tuesday's explosion at the Kano line motor park.

Speaking to our correspondents at the park yesterday, the Discipline Officer of the union, Ahmed Sale, said their findings revealed that 21 passengers, three members

of the union, 10 petty traders and the insurgents died.

He said two suicide bombers detonated the explosives in them while one was set ablaze by a mob at the park when he was trying to escape.

"We don't have the passengers' manifest because the person who loaded the bus died in the blast and the manifest was burnt," he said.

Our correspondent who went to the park yesterday said normalcy had returned.
