



Community pleads for release of murder suspects

Leaders of Usumutong in Abi LGA of Cross River State have appealed to the state police command to release their two sons arrested in connection with the alleged killing of an Assemblies of God Church pastor, Monday Agbor, and a church usher, Ani Ibor Ngurele.

Their spokesman, Asodo Osim Francis Enyiek, urged the police to publish the result of an investigation into the killing of the pastor.

They said their two sons, Victor Ndayo Bassey, a worker with the state water board and George Inyang Bassey were arrested and incarcerated by the police.

Usumutong leaders yesterday, charged the police to conduct proper investigation to fish out killers of the pastor and his aide in February while on their way from Mkpani to Usumutong.

But Police PRO Hogan Bassey said the two men had a case to answer. He said the police have evidence for detaining them.
