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Ex-CJN Bello's son dies in auto crash



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The eldest son of former Chief Justice of Nigeria (CJN), Mohammed Bello, died in an auto crash which occurred on Sunday night.

51-year-old Bashir Bello's car collided with a stationary vehicle along the Kaduna-Zaria express way, a family member, Kabir Yahaya, told Daily Trust yesterday.

He described the late Bashir as an obedient gentleman and prayed Allah to grant him eternal rest.

"Bashir was a gentle and obedient person who never raised a finger against anyone, a testimony of which you can see from his friends here present. He will be missed by all of us and it is incumbent on us to continue praying for the repose of his soul and ensure that we nurse and pray for his children," he said.

Bashir is survived by his wife, Hannatu and five children.

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
