

Missing teacher found dead in Otukpo

A teacher with the Government Model College, Otukpo, Benue State who left his home for a wake keep in a neighbouring community has been found dead. Akpa Onyilo, a father of six who was also a deputy director of education, reportedly left his home at Oyigebe Street on Wednesday for the event which held on Agbenyojo Crescent. Relatives conducted a search and only found his mutilated body along the road in Otukpo GRA.

Family sources said the body which was disfigured beyond recognition was found in a location far from the venue of the wake keep. His wife, Ada Onyilo, a lecturer at the College of Education, Oju, expressed shock at the death of her husband, adding that God would judge the matter.

State police spokesman, DSP Austin Ezeani, said the command was yet to receive the report. Daily Trust however gathered that the corpse was picked by men of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) and deposited at the General Hospital.
